The primary functions will be to coordinate, implement, and manage the quality assurance function to the requirements of current SQF 2000: Level 3 Standards. The position will report to the Vice President of Operations.

Primary Responsibilities:

In this role, you will:

- Prioritize, schedule, and delegate work assignments, and directly supervise the quality assurance staff to ensure the meeting or exceeding of quality specifications and standards of SQF 2000: Level 3 Standards.
- Establish and implement quality procedures and specifications, testing procedures, and standards for raw materials and for in-process and finished products.
- Develop relationships across the organization by being a valued partner and team member.
- Audit quality systems, initiating corrective action as required.
- Develop and recommend inspection and sampling techniques and quality assurance plans.
- Develop process control procedures ensuring production of finished products meeting quality specifications and standards.
- Develop training for and train employees on quality related practices and system requirements.
- Produce quality reports; analyze information, and address and resolve problem areas.
- Develop and lead cross-functional teams to address and resolve quality issues and to improve levels of quality and productivity.
- Provide technical assistance to customers, vendors, and other departments of the company.
- Resolve any quality issues.
- Conduct research on product defects by using RCA analysis techniques and recommend modifications in product or quality standards where warranted.
- Review all complaints received from customers to determine corrective action.
- Provide assistance to customers regarding quality problems or concerns.
- Develop and maintain departmental budget; ensure maximum utilization of resources within budget constraints.
- Review and approve equipment purchases.
- Ensure compliance with all housekeeping procedures and all quality and safety regulations.

- Requires a bachelor's degree and five to seven years of related experience; or ten to twelve years of progressively responsible related experience; or a combination of education and experience.
